STORMALINA broke in at the start and was corrected before contact could be made with ALL TOO MANY, cut solid splits from just off the inside in hand, shook away through the latter portion of the turn, swung two to three wide for home, held clear under a drive kept busy until the final strides. MIDNIGHT CITRA chased the pace two to three wide under encouragement from three furlongs out, angled four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to willingly cut into the winner while clear of the rest for the place honors. ALL TOO MANY shied in at the start reacting to the breaking inwards STORMALINA, chased inside under coaxing, spun just off the inside for home, proved no match for the top pair while besting the rest to be along for the show. KAYLEIGH'S ROAD four to five wide in pursuit from towards the rear, came under a ride midway on the turn, weakened in the stretch. EGYPTIAN MAGIC chased the pace three to four wide from towards the rear under encouragement from midway on the turn and weakened in the drive. NEJMA three to four wide in pursuit, came under encouragement three furlongs from home, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, weakened in the stretch. LOADED FOR BEAR four wide early on on, shifted in a path or two at the half mile pole, chased two to three wide through the turn, tired in the stretch.
