BOURBON IN MAY made it over to the rail well before departing the homestretch, was patiently ridden tracking the front runners, waited briefly behind MOHICAN for the last few jumps leading up to the quarter pole, saw that foe shift into path two at the head of the stretch and proceeded to slip by, still hugging the rail, got cued up altering course into the three path between the three-sixteenths pole the furlong marker, exploded to the top at the latter station, then drew off smartly, kept to vigorous encouragement. BRAY strung out three wide on both turns, commenced the stretch one wider, straightened away and rallied for the place. STARTING POINT grabbed the advantage shortly after the field had been released, got guided over to the inside route, showed the way, lightly pressed and appearing keen, was put to a drive approaching the end of the second bend, proved no match when confronted by the top one deep into the furlong grounds, weakened late and lost the place. WILLING TO SPEED two wide during the initial stages, was along the rail on the far turn, steadied just behind the ultimate winner in the general area of the five-sixteenths marker, stepped into the lane and launched a mild rally good enough for the last major check. MOHICAN stalked STARTING POINT from path two before tucking along the rail midway on the backstretch, continued along it after departing the backstretch, was maneuvered back into path two at the top of the lane, came up empty. WHERE'S RUDY quickly spotted along the inside route, made no impact. HARDEST PART (GB) two to three wide for over three-quarters, gave way. TANGLED WEB forwardly placed three for six furlongs, folded.
