

OUTSHINE shook off light contact with RHYTHMIA in the shadow of the starting gate, was set down to a vigorous hand ride right afterwards and would remain under such handling all the way to the wire, motored up with a sustained four wide run during the journey on the turn, swung one path farther off the rail into the stretch, maintained its momentum to take over, edged away, kept busy to the end. GUMP tracked the pacesetter from the inside route, angled sharply three wide into the lane, took hold and dove back over to the rail after STRIKE PLAY moved into path three himself for the drive home, rallied willingly to out-fight the aforementioned opponent for place honors. STRIKE PLAY was like a shot coming out of the starting gate, saw the pilot resort to a brisk hand ride nailing down the top, showed the way in path two, being rated along now, facing only a minimal amount of pressure, shifted into path three when called upon more at the head of the stretch, got overhauled by the top one soon afterwards, then proved no match for the runner up in the final furlong. FLASHGUN stalked the pacesetter from path three on the turn, got driven into the five path heading for the three-sixteenths marker, straightened away and lacked the needed response. RHYTHMIA leaned in as the field was sent off and running, striking the left side of the starting gate, had its opportunity to get going properly delayed even further when forced to pull off the winner affer brushing with that foe right afterwards, was sent over to the rail, making it there by the top fo the turn, kept watch isolated from the others, cut the corner into the lane under a drive, failed to make his presence felt. KITCHEN SOUP parked out five wide on the turn, was never involved.
