BAHAMA HALO got guided over to the inside after the break, was lightly hand urged keeping an eye on the leader, slipped into the two path in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, closed the gap and turned for home on practically even terms with LOVE THE POWER, settled into upper stretch before being given her cue, responded positively to take charge by the eighth pole, zig-zagged between the two and the four paths during the run leading up to and then past the sixteenth marker, kicked away nevertheless. NOBLE READY tucked along the rail before reaching the conclusion of the backstretch, got cued up angling out into the three path heading for the three-sixteenths pole, proved no match for the top one. FORRES LILY towards the two path, got roused turning for home, mustered up a rally good energy to claim the show award. MURRELL'S BELLE was under some light hand urging scooting past a pair of foes to grab away the advantage shortly after the start, was put to a firmer hold after having done so, came under attack from the eventual winner as the half was being completed, succumbed after being called upon then steadily backed away. LOVE THE POWER (FR) moved sharply towards the inside after the start, resisted the rider's directives to shift more to the outside by rankly fighting on the bit during the most of the way to the half mile pole, took up chase from the two path on the turn though having settled down quite a bit, gave way after a half. SUNDAY GRAVY broke outward springing from the gate, making some contact with the right side of it, departed the backstretch from the two path and failed to menace. FAST FRANNY settled into the two path after the start, was already under a full drive taking path three for entrance into the stretch, lugged her way over to the inside route at the furlong grounds and tired.
