PAYNES PRAIRIE had the pilot grab hold after ducking inward in an awkward at the break, recovered in short order and attained a prominent placing, was the outermost of a three way pace dispute on the turn, undertaking the role from the three path, began to edge away from the other two during the final jumps around the bend, responded positively when given his cue to extend the advantage, finished comfortably in the clear, crossing the finish line being hand urged.
