HARLAN'S HARMONY away well, departed the backstretch from the three path, stayed within striking distance of the front runners all throughout the run around the bend, was put to a drive spinning into the stretch, made minimal progress on the ones to catch during the next furlong, began to close in more readily afterwards, wrested away the advantage from the second place finisher in the final seventy yards and kicked clear, crossing the wire under a hand drive. HARLAN'S HUNCH bobbled after striking the side of the starting gate, recovered in short order and was placed to some light hand urging to confront the earliest of leaders, that being HELLUVA CHOICE by midpoint down the backstretch, remained under such handling racing as a team with the aforementioned rival from the top of the bend to its bend, got set down for the drive, successfully fended off the nemesis, had no answer when the top one arrived on the scene with under a sixteenth to go, ultimately having to settle for being second best. PANAMA PAPERS sat in midpack from the two path, was asked to pick up the pace coming to the five-sixteenths mairker, got called upon shortly afterwards, mustered up a mild response sufficient enough to claim show honors. HELLUVA CHOICE awaty alertly, was joined by the runner up halfway along the backstretch, raced side by side with that foe for the majority of the opening half, was put to a drive as the battle spilled over into the stretch, kept up the fight until well past the sixteenth pole before weakening. GIANT BROWNIE travelled two wide on the turn, set foot into the stretch and lacked the needed response. KITTEN'S SOLUTION underwent a ground-saving journey, was taken in hand tipping out into the three path after encountering some traffic in the late stages. CAPE COD KID quickly tucked along the inside route, was pulling noticeably on the right side of the bit for a good portion of the initial portion of the opening half, got sent out into path three in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths marker, trailed.
