DAREDEVIL was used by the rider to clear the field and establish control, got put to a firm hold after having done so, settled at a slight distance from off the inside, began to edge away from the closest pursuer, that being a frantically-urged ON TENTERHOOKS as the half was being completed, scampered away, asked for some run briefly while making his way through the furlong grounds, extended the margin the final eighth, ridden out. BOW TIE BOSS ducked in awkwardly as the gate were sprung open, raced around the bend in the two path, having been put to a prolonged drive, never made its presence felt while salvaging second. BECAUSE I'M HAPPY took up the chase from the two path around the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, missed out on place honors. MANDOLIN WINS was pulling on the bit during the initial stages, raced along the outside, was placed in three path at the head of the stretch, made no headway. BREEZY MY WAY three wide and asked midpoint on the turn, failed to respond. ON TENTERHOOKS chased the winner towards the two path for a half before giving way. LEAVE THE LIGHT ON was never involved. WILD DYNAFORMER three wide departing the backstretch, was no factor. MIZUMI along the inside route and heavily roused on the turn, tired.
