SOLDADO hustled up to vie inside GOLDENLION and TRAVELLING MIDAS, poked a head in front approaching the half-mile pole, was confidently handled around the turn with a slim lead, edged away through the furlong grounds and was hand urged home. TRAVELLING MIDAS pressed the early pace outside, tried to get past SOLDADO in earnest approaching the stretch, could not match strides once straightened away but ran on clearly best of the others. AND SEEK raced three wide around the turn, could not threaten the top two but edged ALLURSTRA for the show with an even finish. ALLURSTRA raced four wide around the turn, and lacked the needed bid. THE GIPPER took a slight hop at the break and got shut off between AND SEEK and ALLURSTRA, and never reached contention. JOE DI BAGGIO dropped well back around the turn and continued to fade away. GOLDENLION led early, vied briefly between horses approaching the half-mile pole, and retreated on the turn.
