

BOURBON IN MAY gained position out of gate then raced three wide in first turn, settled nicely rated in good position racing three to four wide in backstretch, picked up pace at three eighths pole, inched way up near lead at quarter pole, given cue turning for home then drifted out under right handed drive, came in few paths and gained clear command a furlong out and kept clear under driving finish. MANTRA broke in at start, secured inside position in first turn then angled out, made move past the half mile marker and quickly loomed up close racing five wide at quarter pole, drifted out wide in stretch, continued with response for second best. RED SORRELL was allowed to settle out of gate, saved ground racing in last flight though backstretch, steadily

advanced closer contention in far turn then had to wait for running room, blocked turning for home then made two wide move and split foes past sixteenth pole to gain share. BAD BOY rated off early pace, steadily moved up into closer contention in far turn, fanned five wide turning for home then lugged in bit, kept under left handed urging and evened out late. WHERE'S OLIVER raced in last flight, continued patiently ridden in far turn then went to make move, lacked racing room and altered course upper stretch, improved late. FORT KING brushed bit nearing first turn, dueled inside of SKYCHIEF through backstretch, continued battle in far turn, briefly held slim lead top stretch then wore down by winner. AUGER forwardly placed out of gate then bumped and steadied nearing first turn, stalked along inside in backstretch, waited for room at quarter pole, angled three wide entering topstretch then flattened in late stages. JAMMING EDDY raced off pace, hustled up three wide between foes at quarter pole then got bumped entering top stretch and flattened out. CHANDLER'S DRAMA raced off the pace then three wide at quarter pole, shifted wide for racing room entering top stretch then lacked needed rally. LUCKY MIKE raced midpack along inside, waited in far turn then lacked racing room top stretch, steadied and angled out failed to kick on. SNOOSE GOOSE stalked the top two leaders, hustled up between foes at quarter pole then bumped top stretch and faded. SKYCHIEF dueled for the lead through backstretch, battled into far turn, began to flatten bit turning for home then bumped top stretch and faded.
