

TOM'S D'ETAT towards the two path taking up the chase during the early stages, tipped into path three approaching the half mile pole, cruised his way to the front end shortly after the third fraction had been finalized, turned for home with some revved-up pursuers after him was asked for a bit more after being straightened away, kicked away to a comfortable advantage, best described as being mildly ridden out, before getting confidently wrapped up in the final forty yards. WOODERSON stayed along the inside during the journey leading up to the crown of the clubhouse bend, was gradauilly worked into path three making his way around it, raced four wide, as the widest of all, on turn two, having been asked for more past its midway point, swung into path five entering the stretch, finished with willingness en route for the place. GOLDEN BROWN lunged in springing from the gate, brushing with it prior to brushing with TOUR DE FORCE, tucked into the two path before leaving the homestretch, continued on it at the back of the pack, got cued up angling sharply six wide into the stretch, proved no match rallying for the show. BACKYARD HEAVEN three wide on the first turn, moved closer to the rail once on the backstretch, was coaxed stalking the pacesetter, hitched up to that rival at the half mile pole, took over the lead momnentarily in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole just as the winner was unleashing a menacing bid himself one path farther off the rail, got overhauled by that confidently-ridden opponent, stayed forwardly placed until right around the three-sixteenths marker then steadily backed away. CARLINO took the inside route until the end of the second bend, fanned out into path for the stretch run, made no impact. YOU'RE TO BLAME scraped the gate with its shoulder after leaning in with his initial step, raced three wide on the turn one, but a bit closer to the rail on the next one, was put to a drive nearing the quarter pole, failed to fire appreciably. AMERICAN TATTOO (ARG) away the quickest, yielded the top

GOLDEN BROWN at the start, cut over to the inside with the lead on the first turn, showed the way, tailed by BACKYARD HEAVEN to the outside, relinquished readily as three-quarters was being completed, retreated down the lane. CANDYGRAM pursued the front runners stationed path three on both turns, was induced into shifting about seven wide as GOLDEN BROWN was maneuvering to the outside himself into the stretch, appeared to have little left and backed away.
