READY DANCER chased the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn, was carried five wide into the stretch, made a bid on the outside at the three-sixteenths, was put to a right-handed whip shortly thereafter, switched to a left-handed whip while taking the lead near the eighth-pole then drew clear under strong urging. CONDOMINIUM showed good speed, went to the front, set the pace while well off the inside, controlled the tempo while in the three path on the turn, floated four wide under a strong hand ride into the stretch, came under a left-handed whip inside the three-sixteenths, lost the advantage near the furlnog marker, switched to a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished then eased up late while clearly second best. SAIL AHOY was off a step slow, one of three to break in a second flight, was urged along while well back on the outside, went around the turn in the three path and was along for the show while no danger to the top two. ATTRACTION was urged along between horses, went around the turn in the three path, came under the whip at the quarter-pole, dropped well behind the top two while under a drive in upper stretch and weakened then lost the show. AZTEC SENSE broke a step slow then bumped lightly with MIDNIGHT SURFER, raced well back in the field under coaxing, went around the turn in the two path, drifted in behind a tiring rival in upper stretch, altered course towards the outside approaching the furlong marker and failed to threaten. MIDNIGHT SURFER broke a step slow then bumped lightly with AZTEC SENSE, was ridden along while off the pace, went three then two wide on the turn and came up empty. HUNDRED YEARS was sent hard from the start, dropped back while hard ridden at the five-eighths, raced inside for most of the turn, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, leaned in under a left-handed whip in upper stretch and was no factor. FASHIONABLE FREDDY was urged along in the front half of the field, chased while hard ridden along the rail on the turn and retreated.
