Footnotes

EIDMILAAD rode the hedge for almost three-quarters, slipped into the two path, waited a little while longer then challenged for command as the field entered the lane, fought its way to the front by midstretch, edged away under good handling. ITS ALL RELEVANT broke sharply, established control and was placed along the inside route all before crossing the finish line for the initial time, got rated on a loosely-contested lead and would remain so until approaching the quarter pole, spun into the stretch with a couple of revved-up rivals in hot pursuit and was let out in response, got collared with about a furlong to go, continued onward in a willing manner to procure the place. DISSIDENT acted rankly after springing from the gate, leading the pilot to steady the mount, went about better thereafter, took up the chase primarily from the two path, was put to encouragement swinging one path wider into the stretch, lacked the needed late response and had to settle for the show. BALLAGH ROCKS strung out mostly three wide on the first turn, made no headway during the stretch run. CUMBERLAND RIVER on the verge of sputtering well of the inside heading for the opening bend, was yanked on the left rein by the rider as a countermeasure, got successfully put into the two path and would continue on that truer course afterwards, tipped out into the three path by the end of the backstretch, got set down for the drive, split rivals in midstretch, made no impact once safely through the hole. PINSON off to a stutter step start, broke last, was asked some by the rider but remained slow to settle into stride proceeding along the homestretch, angled three wide into the backstretch, left it being just about as wide, picked up interest when asked to on the far turn, fanned out into the six path from upper to midlane, mustered up a response good enough to mainly improve position. BAYOU BANKER tucked along the hedge shortly after the start, was pulling on the bit all the way to the half mile pole, failed to menace. MEDICI three wide on the first turn, was strung out in the four path on the next one, folded. CHERRY WINE became fractious in the gate, rearing up twice, high enough each time to have its head peek over the top of the gate, was calmed down enough to get backed out, was given a good

lookover by the track veterinarian stationed at the gate before being re-mounted and reloaded, broke without apparent mishap, even with the field being released right after he settled into his stall, raced three wide on the clubhouse turn, moved or drifted out a couple of paths wider after making it onto the backstretch, travelled three to four wide on the far turn, ventured outward after spinning into the lane, left the furlong marker placed near the eighth path, completed the stretch run the same way it got started, put to light urging by the pilot. MARRAKECH stalked the pace from the two path in the early going, too far back to put on any real pressure, was one path wider of the start of the run around the far turn, gave way after going six furlongs.
