Footnotes

NO SHENANIGANS just off the inside into the far turn, raced four wide into the lane, reached the front then drifted in leaving the furlong grounds and edged clear. NUMB LIPS clipped heels and stumbled heading into the clubhouse turn, was four wide into the lane, angled in late and finished willingly. DUELING ALEX made an outside run entering the far turn and reached the front, battled into midstretch, was forced in some leaving the furlong grounds and weakened. CACTUS CHARLIE vied for the lead between rivals entering the far turn and weakened in the drive. AFRICAN DIAMOND vied for the lead, raced along the inside into the far turn and also tired in the drive. FOUR SHORE trailed early and in the three path turning for home, lacked the needed late response. STELLWAGEN raced well placed three wide and weakened into the lane. GREATSILVERSAINT came out some heading into the clubhouse turn, raced near the rail and weakened on the final turn. LUCKIEST MAN vied for the early lead, saved ground and weakened rounding the final turn.
