BALLET CORPS moved up three wide around the far turn then was no match for the winner through the stretch. NAUSHON broke alertly and contested the pace for six furlongs then faded in the drive. EMOSEWA broke a step slowly then raced close up inside and lacked the needed bid. SWEETTINA raced close up outside rivals early then tired. MUSICAL MANDATE lacked a rally. JOYFUL SUZAN vied for the early lead along the inside then tired and was being eased up in deep stretch.
